北京大学汉语暑期学校向全球热爱中文的国际学生 开放,项目开设四周、六周和八周的汉语课程。汉 语暑期学校不开设汉语零基础班,也不招收汉语水 平接近汉语母语者的学生。汉语课每天 4 学时,每 周 20 学时,由北京大学对外汉语教育学院负责授 课。为帮助学生更好地了解中国,汉语暑期学校将 在常规汉语课的基础上,开设有关中国国情和中国 文化的系列讲座课(英文讲授,免费选修)。项目 期间也将组织多种文化参观活动和中外学生交流联 谊活动。

B. 汉语教学:汉语课主要有汉语精读课与汉语口语课。

课 程	教学重点	教材
汉语精读	侧重于提高学生的书面表达能力。 通过学习汉语的词汇、语法等,对学生的综合能力,特别是读写能力进行训练。	《博雅汉语》或《走进中国》
汉语口语	侧重于提高学生口头表达能力。 通过学习口语中常用的词汇与句式等,提高学生运用汉语进行交际的能力。	《博雅口语》或《走进中国》

C. 汉语编班: 汉语暑期学校采取小班教学,根据学生自评成绩分班,每班人数约8至20人。

主要面向有一些汉语基础,学习过拼音和最常用的汉字,可以理解、使用一些最简单的汉语词语和句子,汉语水 平在 HSK 一级 (词汇量 150)以上的学习者。

主要面向有一定的汉语基础,可以就熟悉的日常话题进行简单的交流,汉语水平在 HSK 三级(词汇量 600)以

主要面向有较好的汉语基础,可以用汉语完成日常生活、学习等方面的基本交际任务,汉语水平在 HSK 四级(词 汇量 1200)以上的学习者。

主要面向汉语水平在 HSK 五级(词汇量 2500)以上的学习者,可以比较顺利地用汉语交流、讨论比较广泛的话题 但在表达的准确性、复杂度和得体性方面还远未达到汉语母语者水平。

D. 汉语自评

被录取后,学生需在规定时间内完成在线汉语水平自评测试,汉语暑期学校根据测试结果评估每位学生的汉语能力,将学生编入不同水平 的班级分班教学。在线汉语水平自评测试办法将在录取后以邮件通知。

讲座课

A. 上课时间:每周2次,每次2学时,入学后通知具体时间 B. 讲座主题: 中国历史文化、语言学习方法及跨文化交流等 C. 讲座语言: 英语

成绩单与证书

关于汉语课,项目结束后两周内,北京大学向符合条件的学生提 供成绩单和进修证书。如果学生缺课超过课时总数的四分之一, 则无法获得进修证书。成绩单为每人一份,成绩采取百分制,附 有课程总学时和学生出勤情况。

关于讲座课, 学生出勤达到在学期间讲座总数的四分之三以上, 可以获得参加课程证明。

The Peking University Chinese Language Summer as well as exciting student exchange activities. School is aimed at students from all over the world with an interest in Chinese. The summer school is offered as a four-week, six-week, or eight-week of Chinese program. Chinese Language Summer School does not open foundation course for zero Chinese ability students, nor accept close to native Chinese ability students. In order to help students better understand China, in addition to the Chinese language instruction, the PKU Chinese Language Summer School provides a series of free lectures on interesting facets of China's society and culture, which includes regular visits to well-known attractions in Beijing,



Chinese Language course

The courses are Intensive Chinese Reading and Spoken Chinese. All courses are taught in Chinese.

Class arrangements

Classes will be divided into 4 levels—elementary, preintermediate, intermediate and advanced. Students will be required to take an online Chinese language assessment after paying application fees. There will be 8-20 students

Chinese Language Summer School does not open foundation course for zero Chinese ability students, nor accept close to native Chinese ability students.

Chinese language assessment

All the successful applicants will be required to take an online Chinese language assessment, and students will be placed into different classes according to the assessment results. The Chinese language assessment will be sent to the admitted students by email.

Lectures

Culture lectures will be held twice per week and last two hours each. All lectures will be conducted in English. These

lectures will be on subjects such as Chinese history and culture, language learning methods and cultural exchange.

Transcript and Certificate

Upon completion of the language course, students who meet the assessment requirements will be issued with a certificate and a transcript. Students who attend more than 75% of culture lectures will receive an additional certificate of attendance.

Extracurricular Activities

Peking University offers program students a series of extracurricular activities to experience Chinese culture and get a deeper understanding of China. The following activities are currently planned but are subject to change.
